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




Where we've been: the first decade of Postgraduate NP Residency Training Programs






Today: Primary Care, Specialty and Sub-Specialty NP/PA Postgraduate Training Programs – Total 241 Programs Nationally

In June 2019, HRSA awarded 36 grants to entities in 24 states to increase primary care providers in community-based settings. Eight awards were for new programs; twenty eight were to expand existing programs.

In April 2020, HRSA issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity for the Advanced Nursing Education Nurse Practitioner Residency Integration Program (ANE-NPRIP) to enhance existing programs.


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








What do you (clinicians) think of quality of care?


