



UCSF: APP Organizational Structure




UCSF Health Advanced Practice Organizational Chart FY22 (03/2022)



 - 8 certificate pathways
 - Interactive workshops
 - At your own pace, accelerated, or cohort options
- Teaching Scholars Program: https://meded.ucsf.edu/faculty-educators/faculty-development/teaching-scholars-program
 - After completion General Teaching Certificate (Teach for UCSF)
 - Hold a UCSF appointment for at least one year as a teacher/educator in any of the graduate division professional schools
