










Q4. Please indicate the extent to which you agree with the following statements:

- Eight programs received initial accreditation, two programs received renewal of accreditation, eight programs are in the accreditation pipeline for initial accreditation and two programs for renewal of accreditation in 2022.
- Accreditation Site Visitor Training Course: “A Day in the Life of a Site Visitor”-The two-day, CE-approved accreditation site visitor training course uses a hybrid, web-based, simulation model to train site visitors to the Consortium’s accreditation philosophy, practice and process.
- There were twenty participants from AL, AZ, CA, CT, GA, HI, IL, KS, MA, NY, WA and Washington, D.C.

- Accreditation Standards Review Committee revising Consortium’s Accreditation Standards

The Consortium's petition for federal recognition was submitted to the U.S. Department of Education (ED) on **November 22, 2019**.

On **February 27, 2020** -A hearing before the National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI). NACIQI voted, unanimously, to recommend that the Secretary of Education grant the initial recognition for a 5-year period. The U.S. Department of Education Staff also recommended that the Consortium become Federally recognized by the Department.


On **January 14, 2021**, then Principal Deputy Undersecretary issued a final decision denying the Consortium's Petition for Initial Recognition in her capacity as the Senior Designated Official.

The Consortium provided its notice of intent to appeal that decision on **January 19, 2021** and an Official Appeal Brief was submitted to the Secretary of Education on **February 10, 2021**.

The new Secretary of Education will render a final decision after taking into account the Senior Department Official's decision, our written submissions on appeal, the Senior Department official's response to the appeal, if any, and the entire record before the senior Department official.

Currently, we are awaiting a decision from the Secretary regarding the NNPRFTC's recognition.

- Hosted quarterly webinars for HRSA's ANE-NPR grantees as part of HRSA's cohort collaboration requirement
- Led leadership forums with the Consortium's accredited Programs
- Hosted series of Six Web Café Webinars following annual 2020 and 2021 conferences
- Provided two-day, CE-approved accreditation site visitor training course (20 participants)



What other webinars/topics are members interested in in 2022?

- Deliver the 2022 Annual Conference via In-person/virtual hybrid (solicit ideas and feedback from members)
- Responded to HRSA's NOFO (HRSA-22-109) for Health and Public Safety Workforce Resiliency Training Program
- Commitment to address provider burnout and promote resiliency by offering trainings to postgraduate NP and NP/PA programs, trainees and staff
- Provide training modules for Program Directors and trainees (e.g. professional development and preceptor trainings)
- Support standard program evaluation and ongoing research efforts
- Continue the Accreditation Commission's work on revising the accreditation standards
- Offer 2-day accreditation site visitor training course
- Website updates and enhancements (including information on specialty programs)
- Continue to explore a universal application matching program
- Increase utilization and resources on the community forums
